The overall purpose of this course is to provide students with the in-depth knowledge and skills on discourse analysis and its application in the context of English language teaching.

During the course students will:

study the theoretical foundations of discourse analysis and its role in teaching a foreign language;

learn about methods and tools for analyzing various types of discourse, including oral and written ones;

study modern approaches to the analysis of intercultural discourse, the influence of cultural differences on linguistic interaction;

develop skills for conducting critical analysis of English-language discourse, including linguistic and sociolinguistic approaches;

use accumulated knowledge and skills in the field of discourse analysis for the independent development and conduct of classes in English, taking into account discursive features.

7. ОБРАЗОВАТЕЛЬНЫЕ ТЕХНОЛОГИИ

- 1. Flipped Classroom. The Flipped Classroom Model basically involves encouraging students to prepare for the lesson before the class starts. Thus, the class becomes a dynamic environment in which students elaborate on what they have already studied. Students prepare a topic at home so that the class the next day can be devoted to answering any questions they have about the topic. This allows students to go beyond their normal boundaries and explore their natural curiosity.
- 2. Design Thinking. This technique is based on resolving real-life cases through group analysis, brainstorming, innovation and creative ideas. The Case Method prepares students for the real world and arouses their curiosity, analytical skills and creativity.
- 3. Self-learning. Curiosity is the main driver of learning. As a basic principle of learning, it makes little sense to force students to memorize large reams of text that they will either begrudgingly recall or instantly forget. The key is to let students focus on exploring an area which interests them and learn about it for themselves.

8. ОЦЕНОЧНЫЕ СРЕДСТВА ДЛЯ ПРОМЕЖУТОЧНОЙ ATTECTAЦИИ Questions and tasks to do at the exam

Some of the questions to discuss at the exam:

- 1. Definition of the discourse and its significance in linguistic analysis.
- 2. Comparison and contrast between Conversation Analysis and Critical Discourse Analysis as theoretical frameworks in discourse analysis.
- 3. The role of context in shaping discourse and how it influences interpretation.
- 4. Discourse analysis and its role in uncovering power relations and ideologies in texts.
- 5. The differences between spoken and written discourse.
- 6. Grice's Cooperative Principle and its application to the analysis of conversational implicatures in discourse.
- 7. The concept of intertextuality and analyze how it operates in a specific literary text.

Some practical tasks:

- 1. Analyze a given text and identify the discourse markers and cohesive devices used.
- 2. Critically evaluate a political speech in terms of its discourse strategies and persuasion techniques.
- 3. Analyze a newspaper article and identify the discourse markers used to structure the argument.
- 4. Conduct a conversation analysis of a scripted dialogue from a movie or TV show.
- 5. Compare and contrast the styles of discourse in a formal academic journal article and a casual online blog post on the same topic.
- 6. Analyze a set of social media posts to identify how discourse differs across platforms.
- 7. Choose a political speech or debate transcript and analyze the discourse strategies employed by the speakers.
- 8. Conduct a discourse analysis of a set of advertisements to understand how language is used to persuade and create meaning.
- 9. Examine a legal document or contract to identify the discourse features that make it formal and precise.

10. Analyze a work of fiction (e.g., short story, novel excerpt) to explore character discourse and narrative structure.
